  - Incorporate HSES Committee Scoping Recommendations into Articles of Incorporation, Bylaws, etcetera as needed for Non-Profit Submission Package

### 2. Maintain member paradigm?:

- a. Open to Charitable Contributions? Funding Considerations?
  - General Agreement (with Suggestion) Nov 10<sup>th</sup>: Most indicated agreement to keep the current membership categories; Suggestion also made to add Regional Energy Networks (RENs)
  - Suggestion Nov 10<sup>th</sup>: Continue as Member organization driven, but with tiered fee structure & 501(c)(6) nonprofit trade organization path
  - General Agreement Nov 10<sup>th</sup>: Ensure CEC and CPUC can remain engaged in WHPA

 General Agreement Nov 10<sup>th</sup>: WHPA Should NOT Focus on Lobbying nor Political Action, but rather should remain as a neutral organization for crosscommunication

### 4. Board of Directors:

- a. Executive Committee?
- b. Council of Advisors?
  - General Agreement Nov 10<sup>th</sup>: Board of Directors should NOT be larger than existing Executive Committee (EC)
  - <u>Suggestion Nov 10<sup>th</sup></u>: Make the current EC the Board of Directors initially, but ...
    - Survey EC Members to ensure desired participation & best representation going forward
    - Ensure understanding that Board positions would regularly refresh (1-3 years) to keep WHPA focused on near term and intermediate goals
    - Suggestion Nov 10<sup>th</sup>: Have the Chartering Committee address this concept to ensure a mechanism is in place at the onset
