The WHPA has a long history of engaging with Program Administrators on the development of their programs, and has been lauded by both the CPUC and CEC as an example of what works. Recently, the CPUC, in Decision 15-10-028, has authorized the development of the California Energy Efficiency Coordinating Committee to provide a venue by which *all* public stakeholders can provide early input into the development of the Program Administrators' five-year energy efficiency business plans.

This is another opportunity for WHPA Members to influence the design and delivery of energy efficiency programs in California over the next five years. Business Plans must be submitted to the CPUC on September 1, 2016. Therefore, stakeholders have from now until August 1 to participate in the process.
